Stacia Thiel is an insatiable analyzer of human quirks, twists of fate, and idiosyncrasies. Through searing vocal lines, captivating melodies, and sharp witted lyrics she explores the raw emotions that connect us all in her debut solo album Straight to the Middle.

Americana, alt. country, singer songwriter Stacia Thiel is a classically trained opera singer, born and raised in rural Wisconsin on an eclectic mix of Dixieland Jazz, 60's Folk, and Barbershop harmonies "Whether it was perched on my rooftop as a teen or balanced on my fire escape in Hell's Kitchen," says Stacia, "I've always needed to find a space where I can explore the world through songwriting."



After a move from New York City to the suburbs of NJ, Stacia found herself writing at the kitchen table, late at night against the sweet silence of suburbia. As the songs accumulated, she longed to cut a solo record. A chance meeting led her to producer Scott E. Moore and a dream team was assembled to record at Kaleidoscope Sound w/owner, engineer Randy Crafton including; Dan Rieser (Norah Jones 'Come Away with Me') and Kim Rosen (Aimee Mann 'Mental Illness').

The title track is a fictionalized exchange between two lovers, inspired by a couple arguing outside a NYC coffeeshop where Stacia was sipping a half-caf latte from behind a picture window. It is also a metaphor for the record itself. The songs on Straight to the Middle delve into the vulnerabilities and complexities of life, love and the human experience. "Making this record meant wading into unchartered waters," says Stacia, "and moving toward the unknown in the pursuit of emotional authenticity and expression."
